Scarf—length (excluding fringe) .....	cm	107	112	117	127

**NEEDLES**—Milward or Patons Beehive.  
Size usually required—1 pair 4.00 (No. 8).

**TENSION**—22½ sts. to 10 cm (approx. 4 ins.) in width over stocking st.

Milward Tapestry Needle for sewing seam. Milward Crochet Hook, 4.00 (No. 8) for Fringe.

**ABBREVIATIONS**—See page 2.

M. = Main Colour. C.1 = 1st Contrast. C.2 = 2nd Contrast.

**FIRST**—Check your tension. Read page 2 carefully for notes, abbreviations and how to check your tension.

**CAP**

Using 4.00 (No. 8) Needles and C.1, cast on 116 (122-128-134) sts.

1st row—\* K.1, P.1, rep. from \* to end.

Rep. 1st row 5 (5 - 7 - 7) times.

(continued at top of opposite page)

Using M., knit 1 row, then work 5 (5 -7 -7) rows rib

Using C.2, knit 1 row, then work 5 (5 -7 -7) rows rib

Using M., knit 1 row, then work 4 (4 -6 -6) rows rib

Using M., work 16 (20 – 20 – 22) rows stocking st., beg. with a knit row

Shape crown

1<sup>st</sup> row – K.1, \*sl.1, K1, p.s.s.o., K.17 (18 – 19 – 20), rep. from \* to last st., K.1

2<sup>nd</sup> row – P.1, \* P.16 (17 – 18 – 19), P.2 tog., rep. from \* to last st., P.1

3<sup>rd</sup> row – K.1, \* sl. 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.15 (16 – 17 – 18), rep. from \* to last st. K.1

Cont. dec in this manner in every row until 20 sts. rem.

Next row - \* Work 2 tog., rep. from \* to end.

Break off yarn, run end through rem.sts., draw up and fasten off securely
